
Lodge Activity Group





New District Protocol


Does the District have more than One (1) active Moose Rider Activity Group in the District?

- If "YES", State Chairman will appoint a Temp. District Chairman.
 - All Lodges in the district will be notified of the upcoming District MR Meeting and election of officers, at least 10 days in advance of the meeting.
 - During the first meeting, ALL officers will need to be nominated and elected, this includes a District President.
 - If nobody wants to run for Chairman, the appointed Chairman will become the District Chairman and the Chairman will appoint any remaining <u>un-filled</u> positions.
- If "NO", State Chairman will appoint a District Chairman.
 - All Lodges in the district will be notified of the upcoming District MR Meeting and election of officers, at least 10 days in advance of the meeting.
 - During the first meeting, the rest of the officers will be nominated and elected into office.
 - If any offices remain vacant, the Chairman will appoint any <u>un-filled</u> positions



New District Protocol


- Each officer in the District should be from a different Lodge, if possible.
 - All Lodges have representation.
 - Most times you can not do this due to lack of participation by all Lodges.
- This protocol will be followed until the next regular election, which will be in October of each year.
 - Follow the State Moose Rider Activity Group Guidelines.



Activity Fees


Yearly Fees November 1 - October 31

- State Activity Group Membership- \$5.00




Cards & Charters

- Reports will Be Turned In Quarterly






Community Service Credit

- State Chairman will report Activity Group status during Mid-year and Annual FBMA Convention









Patches

- State Board To Get Acceptance By The Confederation Of Clubs Before Displaying






